## The Fund's Work in 2015

During the first three quarters of the year, we've:

- Made grants amounting to £475,000;
- Assisted 56 current BT people;
- Assisted 321 former BT people, or their dependents;
- Made substantial grants towards bathroom adaptations for 23 people with disabilities;
- Paid for 24 new boilers for elderly people who would otherwise have been without heating;
- Supplied 73 domestic appliances such as cookers, washing machines and fridges;
- Made contributions towards the funerals of 36 former BT people, including a lady of 101 who started work as a GPO telephonist in 1946;

As well as making many other grants for urgent needs including debts relating to housing and purchase of essential items.

**At a time when many charities are struggling to get new members, the Fund's constant focus on this vital source of income continues to pay off.**

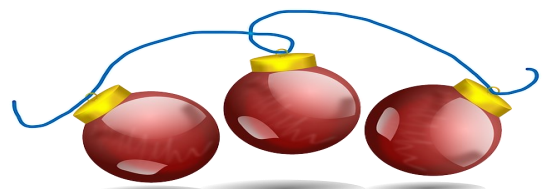
